Dear Tom,

I am writing on behalf of the Fox lake Preservation Organization (FLPO) seeking clarification regarding two lake topics of concern.

The first is the recent clear cutting of Chief Kuno trail roadway. What was the need and purpose of the natural habitat destruction and how was this decision reached?

Our second concern is the repeated instillation of drain pipes on both Blackhawk Trail and Howard Drive. These pipes appear to solve one issue, surface runoff, but allow unfiltered and unrestrained drainage directly into Fox lake. Our question is what was the process in these decisions and which agencies were involved in determining the best course of intervention?

The FLPO would appreciate an explanation for these actions and is requesting the issues be addressed formally at the Town Board meeting on December 10, 2018.

I am sure you would agree that the mission of all lake organizations along with the Town, City and County are to preserve and protect the quality of our soil and waters. Decisions impacting the lake's quality require responsible action across a continuum.
